Departure:

Friday, July 22nd

- Arrive at the church at 4:00 pm.
- Leave from the church at 4:30 pm. Drive to Red River Stock Farm.
- We will get dinner in Springfield, TN.

Plan: This car camping trip

- Patrols will camp in the woods along the bank of the Red River. Location on the map.
- Patrol Base Camping the six patrols will establish their own site. The patrols will make their own fires, cook as a patrol, and create a skit for the campfire. (Grubmasters will be assigned by the Patrol Leaders)

• Saturday morning, July 21st, we will break into groups to work on rank advancement. Trap shooting will be available Saturday morning. We will purchase the shotgun shells for 12 gauge and 20 gauge. If you have a shotgun, please bring it. Gear:

- <u>Attire</u>: Wear clothes and shoes that you can get dirty and keep you comfortable. It will be warm during the day and night. Work with your Patrol Leader/Grubmaster on the packing list, and **Be Prepared!**
- Reminder of things to bring individually or by patrol:

 - Flashlight
 - Camping gear: tent, ground cover, sleeping bag, sleeping pad
 - Fishing Rod

 - Ice Chests
 - Stove, table, fuel, and matches
 - Rope/Twine

Cost:

Return:

We should depart no later than 11:30 AM. You will depart from the farm with your assigned carpool. Lunch is on your own with your carpool, so bring cash for this meal.
